### One or more observed:

- Tardy 2 or more minutes.
- Loud, distracting and inefficient use of pre-class time.
- Major dress code infraction (no dance clothes, missing leotard)
- Two or more incidences of chatting/losing focus.
- Asked to be excused and missed significant dancing time.
- Significant lapse in studio etiquette.
- Did not thank teacher and/or accompanist.
- Any B range indicators that repeat over time.

- Retained sequences only after demo 5 or more times.
- Recalled sequences from previous classes with lots of assistance.
- Demonstrated teacher feedback with little degree of clarity or did not demonstrate.
- Limited improvement with repetition.
- Limited progression toward artistry.
